won by Karl Leonard. At only 20 years of age and in his first season of racing, Smith has proved much and could have a bright future in the sport. Other leading runners include Joe Murray, Nigel Pratt and Liam Rabbitt but none of the drivers has ever raced at Pembrev before, so the form book could be shaken up as they tackle the Welsh circuit for the first time. The Punto title contest will only be resolved this weekend. Drivers such as Gordon Kellett, Garry O'Brien and Liam Denning are the men with a shot at the crown and, if previous races at the Mondello Park circuit are a guide, this should be a real thriller.

A race each day will decide the outcome of the BARC Westfield Sportscar Championship at the conclusion of the best ever season for the category. Packed fields of the two-seater sportscars have been the norm in 1998 and a near capacity grid will assemble for the two



races. Like the 2CVs, the Westfields were at the opposite end of the country two weeks ago for round 12 at Lydden Hill in south-east Kent. Having already had

races at Jurby on the Isle of Man and at Anglesey, the Westfield pack is well travelled this season and the man who has trekked the longest distances has been Northern Ireland's **Lloyd Fowler**. However, having won seven races in a row through the spring and early summer, Fowler has missed the last two races and has now lost his lead in class B (for the more powerful cars) to **lan Stinton**.


It seems likely that Fowler will not be at Pembrey this weekend and so Stinton should secure class B as his closest other rival, **Bill Tully**, is 15 points adrift. **Keith Scarfe** took his first win at Cadwell last month while Jerseyman **Richard Hardy-Bishop** is another of the long-distance Westfield commuters.

Heading for the overall title as class A champion is Midlander **Michael Edmonds** after a marvellous debut season in the category. Invariably well up the class order, Edmonds set the seal on his success with major points hauls in the Anglesey and Jurby double-header races.

However, defending champion, and former Mini racer, **Chris Gould** has often set the pace among the 1700cc Ford engined cars and would probably have been heading the points had he not missed the away races. If Edmonds fails to score, Gould could still just grab the title this weekend but it really is a long shot for the Londoner. **Stuart King, Kevin Pease** and **Keith** and **Jamie Bridgewater** are the other strong class runners.


Matters could not be closer in the final round of the 797 Graduate Challenge as David Williams and Nick Harryet arrive at Pembrey exactly level on points. The 797 Graduate series is based on the successful Caterham Scholarship series in which new drivers compete in a mix of speed events and races in identical Caterham Sevens. As each scholarship year introduces a new crop of starters, the class of 1997 got together to organise a second season of competition along similar lines. The BARC has run a nineround series comprising six races and three speed events and this weekend's race is the final event.

Williams has the slight edge over Harryat when dropped scores are taken into account as he has to drop only seven points, while Harryat will have to drop a 13 if he finishes better than eighth. If both hit dramas, Nick Frost could yet steal the title while **Christian Marryat** won last time out at Mallory Park a month ago.

Completing the race programme are the deciding two rounds in the WRDA Sports/Saloon Car Championship, which both run on Sunday. Ironically, for a series aimed at local drivers, it is the well-travelled **Mark Chandler** who has won the championship title in his Mini Cooper. Mark, who lives near Cambridge, regularly makes the 400-mile round trip to race at Pembrey and has been rewarded with the overall title.

The participation of former triple champion Martin Davies in this race currently hangs in the balance as his Ford Sapphire Cosworth was stolen from the Donington Park paddock two weeks ago when the WRDA contenders had an away race. The fleet Darrians of defending champion Peter Dark, Graham Cole and Gareth Davies should set the pace but the Cosworth powered Fords of Graham Hollis and Keith Butcher will not be far away.

And so the curtain will fall on another season of fine BARC-organised racing at the Welsh Motorsport Centre. A programme of on-going development and improvement continues to make Pembrey a fine race track and worthy of its important place in British motorsport. On behalf of the BARC, we close with a vote of thanks to all volunteer marshals and officials who make it possible to run events at the circuit.




