














Partnering Minassian in the French Promatecme team – the only team using Renault engines – is Brazilian **Enrique Bernoldi**. Having arrived in a blaze of pre-season publicity, Bernoldi missed a couple of races following a road accident and has yet to match the third place he scored in the first race of the season.

Australian **Mark Webber** (winner at Brands) and Brazilian **Mario Haberfeld** (who won the GP race at Silverstone) are the other drivers to have won races so far this year. Webber, winner of the 1996




Enrique Bernoldi – looking for another podium finish. (Sutton)

Formula Ford Festival, arrives at Pembrey fresh from being the first British-based competitor home in the prestigious Marlboro Masters Formula 3 race at Zandvoort two weeks ago. Joining Webber in the Alan Docking squad are Japanese racers **Haruki Kurosawa** and **Yudai Igarashi**, but neither has made much impression to date.

Haberfeld, meanwhile, is racing for Martin Donnelly's newly-created Formula 3 team and has shown everimproving form, culminating with victory in the big race of the year at the Silverstone Grand Prix meeting. Confidence in both the team and the personable Brazilian will be high and Mario will be a strong contender this weekend. Experienced F3 racer Mark Shaw races alongside Haberfeld in the team run by the former Grand Prix racer.


Devonian Ben **Collins** Argentinian Brian Smith have both been podium finishers for Fortec Motorsport, while Kevin McGarrity races the increasingly competitive TOM's chassis and offers the only challenge to the allconquering Italian Dallaras. Alongside him will be another rising Brazilian star in the form of Ricardo Mauricio. Guy Smith started the season with an excellent second at Silverstone for the DC Cook team but since then has struggled to match the pace of the leaders. He is joined in the team by the hard-charging Paula Cook.

The underrated **Darren Manning**, who subbed impressively for Minassian earlier

Unipart DCM Mini Seven Challenge

Reigning champion **Phil Manser** should have a great chance of closing the gap to points leader **Dave Braggins** as the Mini Seven pack make a welcome return to Pembrey. Braggins is scheduled to miss this race while away on holiday and his early-season championship dominance is now under threat.

After a season of dreadful luck last year, Braggins was the man to beat over the opening races as the bad luck moved to Manser. Now, however, Manser is on a roll and comes to Pembrey having completed a hat-trick of wins at Donington two weeks ago. The other race winner to date this season is **Steve Bell** and he led at Donington before his engine dumped its oil onto the track!

Into second at Donington came local racer **Matt Hayman**. The Dinas Powis charger was enjoying his best race of the season and came very close to beating Manser. He will be buoyed by that result but has one problem this weekend – **Rob Selby** wants his engine back so that he can race it himself!

As ever in Mini Sevens, the list of likely winners is long and some great racing is assured on Sunday morning. Watch for **Tim Sims, Dave Percival, Dave Banwell** and **Mark Sims** to be in the thick of the action.

P+P Supplies Welsh Sports & Saloon Championship

n Saturday afternoon, the local racers go into round ten of the popular Welsh Sports and Saloon Championship. Currently the only race championship based in Wales, the series is open to a wide range of production-based cars in varying stages of modification. Fittingly, the Lampeter-produced Darrians are the cars to beat and the trio of sleek machines handled by **Terry Brown, Peter Dark** and **Graham Cole** are the quickest in the series.

However, the level of competition amongst the Darrians actually counts against them in terms of the overall championship as Ford Sapphire Cosworth racer **Martin Davies** bids for a fourth straight title. While the Darrians take points off each other, Davies has only Bristolian **Keith Butcher** for class opposition with his Escort Cosworth.

Having been the most successful racer last season, Brown has not enjoyed such good fortune so far with his 1000cc motorbike-engined Darrian. He has won three times to date, but Dark, with two wins and three seconds is enjoying better consistency.

The main rival to Davies, however, is likely to be **Nigel Jones** who traded his Honda CRX in for a Ford Sierra Cosworth over the winter. Invariably the class B pacesetter, Jones faces the Porsche 911RSR of **Nigel Bowen** this weekend.

Unipart DCM Mini Miglia Challenge

With four wins from the first seven races, **Bill Sollis** is starting to look the favourite for the Mini Miglia title as the 1300cc slick-shod racers assemble at

Pembrey. If the London fireman does clinch the title, it will be a popular victory as Bill has finished in the top three of the championship in each of the last five seasons. The top step on the podium has, however, always eluded him.

With the car he built for the start of 1996 and a fresh Richard Longman engine, Bill is having a great season and a fourth place at Spa is his worst result to date! The man chasing Sollis is **Ian Curley**, who is also having his best-ever season in the category. Ian won at Spa – for the second time – and chased Sollis home in the most recent race at Donington.

Chris Lewis, a former triple champion, is back again this year and won the opening round at Oulton on Good Friday. However, that is his best finish to date and the Yorkshire racer needs to beat Sollis this weekend to keep his title hopes alive as the drivers contest round eight of 13. The evergreen Peter Baldwin, the ever improving Julian Sole and Welsh charger Wayne Grayer are some of the other leading contenders.

The Welsh Racing Drivers Association Sports Saloon Championship, based at Pembrey circuit, continues for its sixth season in 1996, and this year enjoys the support of P+P Supplies Limited, of Cardiff.

Points will be awarded to registered competitors listed as classified finishers in the Final Results as follows:- 4 or more eligible starters in the class: 1st - 4; 2nd - 3; 3rd - 2; 4th -1. 3 eligible starters in the class: 1st - 3; 2nd - 2; 3rd - 1. 2 eligible starters in the class: 1st - 2; 2nd - 1. 1 eligible starter in the class: 1st - 1, plus one extra point for the competitor(s) achieving or equalling the race fastest lap in the class. In the case of only one starter to the class the point will be awarded if the race fastest lap equals or betters the class lap record.
